Registration is from 8:00am-8:30am. Be sure your team is **checked in by 8:30am** the day of the tournament. This will allow time for the round robin tournament and brackets to be set up prior to play at 9:00am.

We continue to ask that **team captains** report wins, losses, and scores to the registration table upon completion of each game. This will assure accuracy for tournament placement.

*This year you are welcome to bring your own beverages, but we ask that you refrain from bringing glass bottles for the safety of all participants. We ask that you support the vendors participating in the festival; however, we also realize there may not be enough time to get food between games so feel free to pack a cooler.

***Drinking alcoholic beverages will only be permitted on the east side in the grass. You may be fined by the City of Spooner in the amount of \$177.00 for drinking on the dirt road or the volleyball courts.**

Rules and regulations are subject to change based on the number of teams, weather, and time. The Jack Pine Volleyball tournament is played rain or shine!

Jack Pine Savage Volleyball Rules and Regulations

Teams

1. Only one more player than the lowest number of the opposite sex.
2. Male, female rotation with a minimum of one female in the front.
3. Switching may take place once the ball is in play.
4. You may only play on 1 team during the tournament.
5. You may not recruit other members from other teams once they are eliminated from the tournament.

Scoring Regulations

1. Rally scoring will be used.
2. There will be a point scored on every serve of the ball.
3. Offense will score on a defense miss or out of bounds hit.
4. Defense will score on an offensive miss, out of bounds hit, or serve into the net.
5. The 1st 2 games will be played to 25 points*.
6. The 3rd game will be played to 15 points*.
7. Must win by 2 points.

Serving Regulations

1. Volley for serve.
2. Team who wins volley chooses side or serve.
3. Serves may be underhand, overhand, or jump serve.
4. Blocking the serve is illegal.



Jack Pine Savage Volleyball Rules and Regulations

Legal & Illegal Hits

1. The ball must be cleanly hit. The following constitutes a **legal hit**: contacting the ball with the heels of the hands, fists, arms, head, or feet.
2. The following constitutes **illegal hits**: ball visibly comes to rest, held ball, spiking from the back row (back row cannot rotate to the front row to spike; otherwise follow the 10' rule), successive contacts, using fingers for an underhand hit, or attacking a serve.
3. Teams are responsible for calling illegal hits on themselves.
4. If teams disagree the point should be replayed.

Penalties

1. Lifts/double hits
2. Out of bounds
3. Net touch
4. All penalties will result in returned possession to the other team.

Team Captains

1. Team captains are responsible for reporting wins, losses, and scores to the registration table upon completion of each volleyball game.

***Points played are subject to change depending on number of teams in the tournament.**
